✓ 3 competitive calls

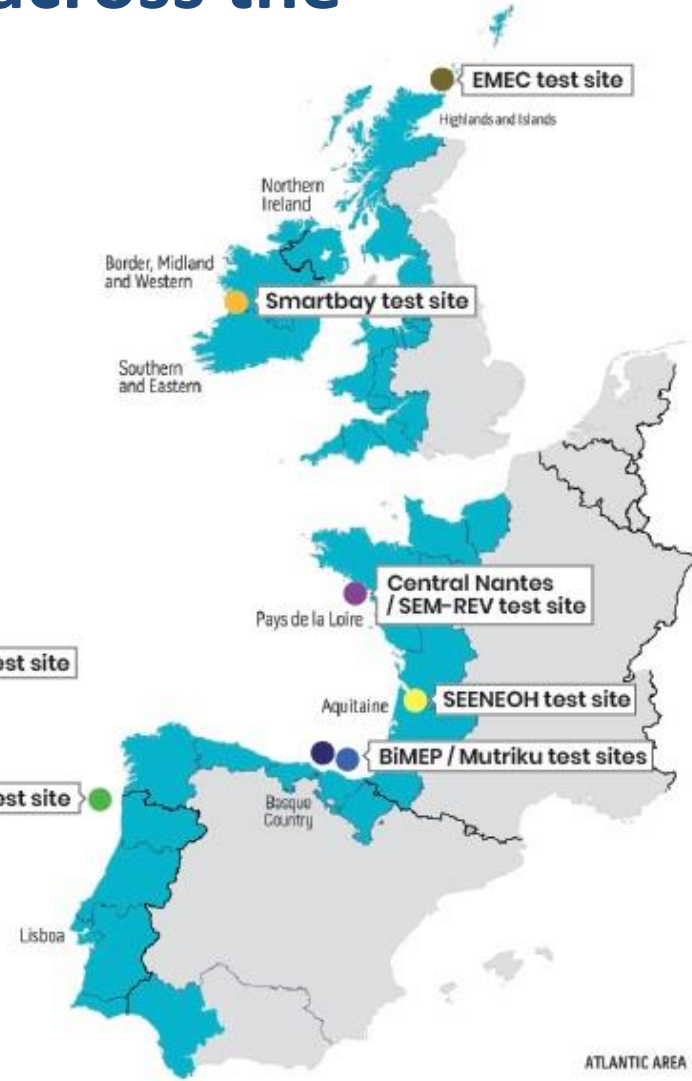
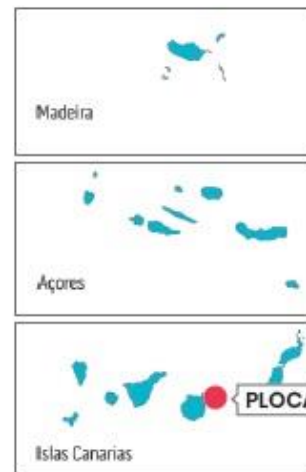
A series of **test site access vouchers** will be offered to successful applicants to support **testing of devices and subsystems** at the test centres:

A consortium of 7 MRE test sites across the Atlantic Arc:

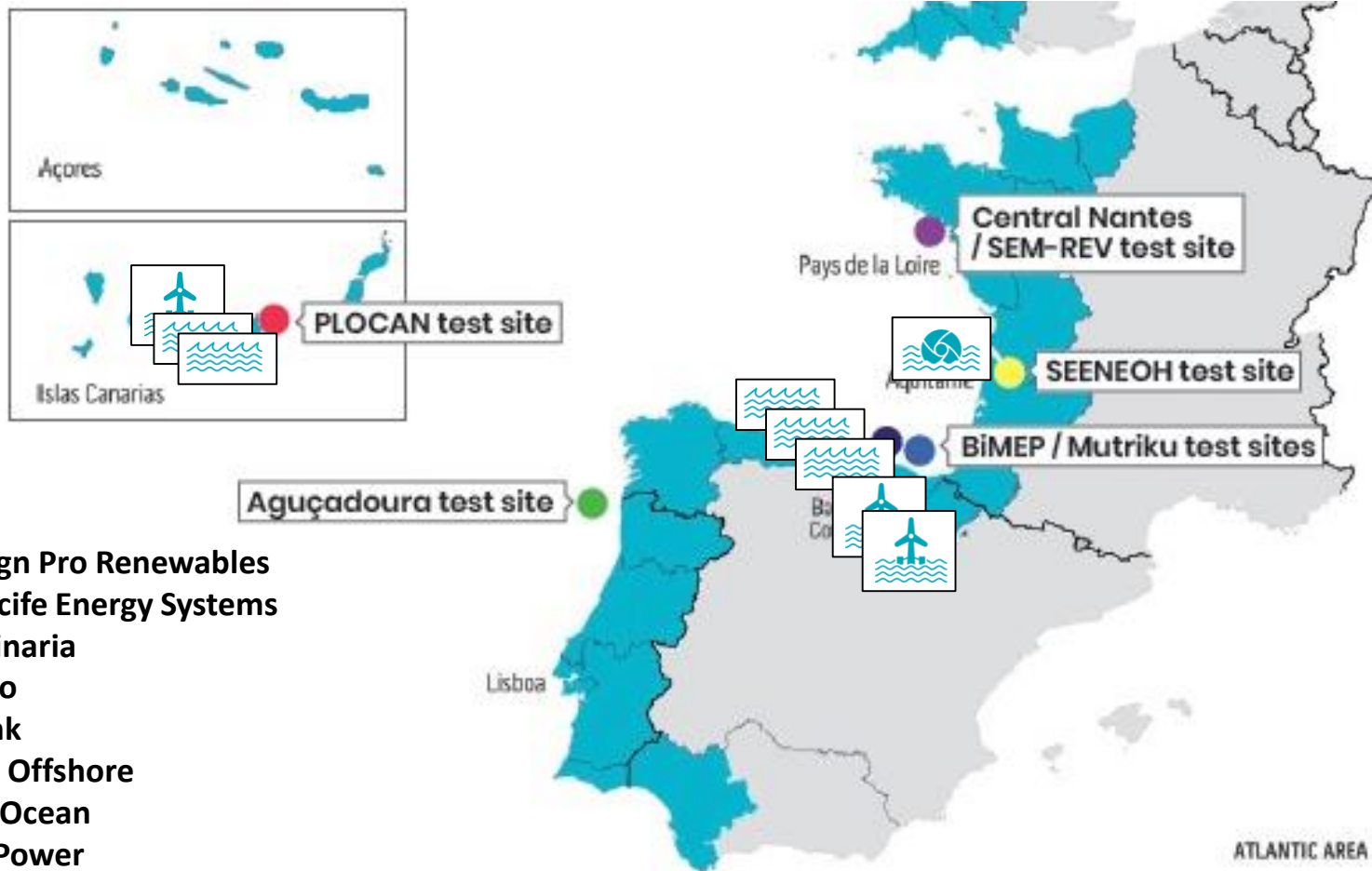
